## Ways to give without cost

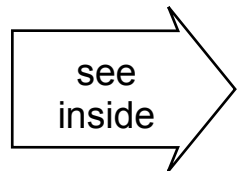
### UK Tax Payers

If you pay tax in the UK you can sign a **Gift Aid Declaration** that enables APF to recover the tax from the government. This increases the value of your gift by 25% at no extra cost to yourself. If you have already signed a Gift-Aid form for APF there is no need to sign another. If you wish to make a cash donation under an existing Gift Aid arrangement it would need to be in an envelope with your name on.

Gift Aid forms are included in the response form with each mailing.

### Internet Shoppers

Many online retailers will give a percentage of their sales to charities at no extra cost to you. You can nominate APF as your charity of choice by using one or both of the methods in the following pages of this leaflet. You can change your nominated charity at any time

# Fundraising for APF

Would you like APF to get a donation every time you buy something? Well it can if you shop on the internet. A small percentage of each transaction is automatically added to APF's account when your goods are paid for. This doesn't cost you any more than usual. How does it work? Well retailers are happy to get new customers on their websites and will offer a small percentage of the purchase price to charities and community organisations that register with one of the companies set up to do this. Online shopping is now quite secure (check the browser has a 'padlock' symbol for the payment page if you are worried). There are two methods for APF supporters to use: 'Easy Fundraising' and 'Give as you Live'. You may want to register with one or both of these organisations and select African Pastors Fellowship as your chosen charity (you can change this at any time - although hopefully you won't want to).

The two fundraising agencies differ slightly in how you use them:

'Easy Fundraising' requires you to always go to the shop's webpage *through* the Easy Fundraising website. So you would bookmark Easy Fundraising - go to their website and then use the search box on their web page to find the shop you want. You are then re-directed to the normal webpage for your shop and carry on shopping as normal. The shop recognises which page you entered the site from and therefore knows where to donate the money.

'Give as you Live' is an add-on application for your web browser (Firefox, Internet Explorer and Safari are currently supported). It runs in the background and every time you search a shopping web-site it opens a sidebar with the item you are looking for listed in all of the registered shops that will donate a percentage to APF with the price it is being offered at so you can see the comparison instantly. Shopping with one of these registered shops automatically gives the donation to APF.

Unfortunately not all the same shops are supported - so if you shop with Amazon it is only possible to use Easy Fundraising at present. Other things like new subscriptions to the National Trust or a change to a new car insurance (not renewals) offer a one-off donation to a charity of choice.

- Use one of the methods above to donate without cost to you each time you shop online.

# Registering with Easy Fundraising

1. Go to [www.easyfundraising.org.uk](http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk)

2. Click on the 'Register as a user' button

3. In the 'Charity/Organisation' box type in "african pastors" and then click the 'search' button.

4. In the radio buttons that now appear underneath the box where it says "Please choose" you should see 'African Pastors Fellowship' as the first entry with the round button next to it filled in - when it is then click the "next" button at the bottom of the box.

5. African Pastors Fellowship is now listed as your selected charity - fill in the rest of your details to register and make sure you click the box at the bottom to accept the terms and conditions.

6. You should now see a 'Welcome' screen - You may want to click 'Home' at this point and bookmark the site for future use - (Press Ctrl-D).

7. The Search box at the top allows you to search for registered shopping websites that will give a donation to APF - try 'Marks and Spencer' for example.

8. From the list that appears click on the 'Visit store' button for the site you want and continue to shop (you may have to register with the shop or log-in with your username and password).

9. So long as you start from the Easy Fundraising website each time you shop any purchase you make will qualify for a percentage to be given to APF.



# Downloading 'Give as you live'

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Go to [www.giveasyoulive.com](http://www.giveasyoulive.com)
3. Click the blue 'Download the app' button (or use the link from the APF website)
4. Click the 'install' button in the box that appears. Then Click 'save' accept the default location and when it has finished downloading click 'run' in the box that appears. You may have to click 'run' or 'yes' in any further boxes that appear.
5. When the User Agreement appears click 'I agree' (after reading it of course!)
6. Accept the default location and click 'install'. If you haven't already done so you may now be prompted to close Internet Explorer before the installer continues.
7. When it has completed installing click 'next' then 'finish'.
8. Open Internet Explorer (or close it and open it again)
9. Click on 'Sign up' to create an account.
10. In the 'What charity would you like to support' box type "african pastors" and click 'search'
11. Select African Pastors Fellowship and click 'next'
12. You should now see the APF symbol and name - click 'continue'
13. Enter your details, then enter the letters and numbers you can see in to the box underneath (this makes sure you are not a robot!) select the box to agree to the terms and conditions (after reading them of course!) and click 'finish'.
14. You should now see your 'My account' page where you can keep track of your giving and update any details on your account.
15. Now whenever you use search boxes on a website to search for things to buy a sidebar will pop up with suggestions of what to buy from sites that will give a donation to APF.
16. The first time you use the browser you may need to sign in to your account but you should be prompted to do so.
